## **Questionnaire Response: Election 2014**

Thank you for your thoughtful election 2014 questionnaire. I assure you that improving the health and supports for people with chronic conditions is a priority for me personally, for Premier Kathleen Wynne, and for the Ontario Liberal Party.

In Ontario, as is the case in developed countries throughout the world, chronic diseases are the leading cause of death and disability. Almost 80% of Ontarians over the age of 45 have a chronic condition. We know that if left untreated or managed poorly, chronic conditions can deteriorate and predispose individuals to other chronic conditions. We also know that chronically ill Ontarians are also likely to have more than one chronic disease, which is particularly true for Ontarians with arthritis.

With this in mind, the Ontario Liberal government created the Chronic Disease Prevention and Management (CDPM) Framework to guide the redesign of health practices and systems to improve the prevention and management of chronic disease.
